## KEY TECH TOOLS FOR ANY SMALL BUSINESS

The tech tools ANY small business should implement:

- **Cybersecurity** protection systems
- Customer Relationship Management (**CRM**) software
- Human Resources (**HR**) management software
- **Financial management** software
- **Payment solutions**
- **Website** implementation and enhancement tools
- **Mobile** applications
- **Cloud** computing

## CYBERSECURITY

The number one technology small businesses need to take a serious look at in today's world of malware and breaches. Still, Gartner tells us only 68% of SMEs reported currently using these technologies.

You should at the very least have robust anti-virus software like Norton or McAfee installed, but if you're serious, you need to consider installing:

- Network Security Monitoring tools
- Encryption Tools
- Web Vulnerability Scanning tools
- Network Defence Wireless Tools
- Packet Sniffers
- Antivirus Software
- Firewall
- Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) Services
- Managed Detection Services
- Penetration Testing

## CRM



- Important for interacting with clients and efficiently managing and centralizing client data
- If used properly, CRM software automates contact management, communication tracking and scheduling, and sales forecasting
- CRM systems can also interface with bookkeeping/accounting software, and with project planning software
- Examples include Salesforce with over 7 million users), Act! and lesser known options like Insightly and Zendesk Sell

## HR MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE



- Often part of accounting software, particularly for payroll management, etc
- Gives visibility to a global workforce
- Automates administrative functions like managing benefits and attendance
- Can be used to manage entire employee lifecycle, from recruitment to performance assessment and termination
- Examples include ServiceNow, HR Assured and Kronos

## FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE

- Essential for sound financial management, including cash flow management and budget control
- Better strategic planning and analysis
- Streamlines, consolidates and automates accounting processes and reporting
- More accurate and accessible financial information
- Ensures transparency
- Facilitates regulatory compliance, including tax
- Examples include MYOB, Quickbooks and Xero

## PAYMENT SOLUTIONS

- Essential for eCommerce
- Ensures security and data protection
- Engenders trust
- Facilitates instant payments
- Reliable, accepted global payments
- No foreign currency bank account needed
- Examples include PayPal, Stripe Due, AliPay and Apple Pay

## WEBSITE MANAGEMENT & ENHANCEMENT

- Your website is your virtual shop front
- Important to have a site that is secure, loads quickly and is easy to navigate
- Optimize your site for search engines
- Update content regularly
- Synch your website with your digital marketing channels, including social media
- Automate functions such as newsletter distribution, social media postings, etc

## MOBILE TECH



- All tech that ensures your business can function remotely (is literally “mobile”) – devices such as laptops, tablets and smart phones; software that enables remote collaboration and work (e.g. Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Cisco Webex)
- All tech that ensures your marketing is mobile-enabled, including your website
- Apps that promote your business, your products or services, or provide value-add tools for your customers

## CLOUD COMPUTING

*The on-demand availability of computer system resources, especially data storage (cloud storage) and computing power, without direct active management by the user*

- Enables transitioning some of all network management processes and policies to/from a cloud service
- Email is the quintessential cloud computing example
- Software as a Service (SaaS) is also cloud computing
- Cloud computing makes business more agile and more scalable
- Makes business mobile
- Saves money

## A.I.

*The theory and development of computer systems able to perform tasks normally requiring human intelligence, such as visual perception, speech recognition, decision-making, and translation between languages*

**Not just for large businesses! AI can:**

- **Improve sales and marketing (with an AI-infused CRM)**
- **Automate customer communications (with a Chatbot)**
- **Streamline human resource tasks**
- **Acquire competitive intelligence**

*A system of interrelated computing devices, and mechanical and digital machines, provided with unique identifiers and the ability to transfer data over a network without requiring human-to-human or human-to-computer interaction*

Essential part of Industry 4.0

Some benefits for small business:

- Predictive maintenance
- Dynamic inventory control
- Energy management
- Access control

## AUTOMATION

*The technology by which a process or procedure is performed with minimal human assistance.*

**Not just robots!!**

**For small business:**

- **Business process automation (BPA), including supply chain, inventory control**
- **Marketing automation**
- **HR automation**

## BLOCKCHAIN

*A blockchain is a time-stamped series of immutable records of data that is managed by a cluster of computers not owned by any single entity. Each of these blocks of data (“block”) is secured and bound to each other using cryptographic principles (“chain”).*

For small business:

- Payments and money transfers
- Smart contracts
- Digital identity
- Supply chain communications and proof of provenance
- Networking and IoT
- Loyalty programmes

## BIG DATA

*Extremely large data sets that may be analysed computationally to reveal patterns, trends, and associations, especially relating to human behaviour and interactions.*

*Big data is, amongst other things, the underlying “food” for AI.*

**For small business:**

- Use tools to analyse Big Data
- Make use of already mined data bases

## 5G

*The fifth generation technology standard for cellular networks, which cellular phone companies began deploying worldwide in 2019.*

For small business:

- Faster, safer, smarter mobile access
- Rollout is relatively slow, but 5G will be the norm in due course, just as 4G is now




## A WORD ON INDUSTRY 4.0


